



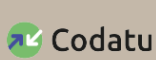

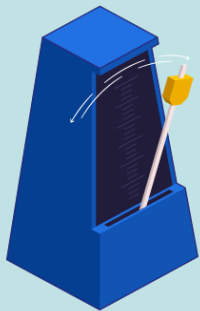
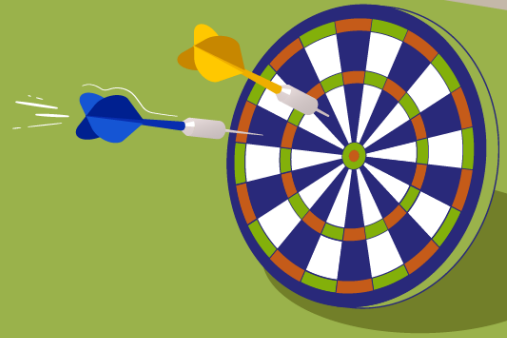
ABIDJAN - 19 TO 22 OCTOBER 2026

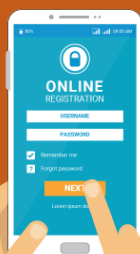
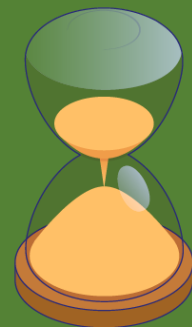
