The **International Conference on Sustainable Mobility and Climate (#CIMDC2026)**, taking place from **19 to 22 October 2026**, in Abidjan, is fast approaching!

Organised by **CODATU, AMUGA and Climate Chance**, the conference will bring together **African and international stakeholders** (local authorities, institutions, businesses, NGOs, researchers, donors and citizen networks) for four days of discussions on sustainable mobility solutions in the face of climate change.

The programme will feature **plenary sessions, workshops, the Pitch Corner and experience-sharing sessions**, structured around four key themes: mobility and urban planning, governance and financing, mobility and climate, and technological and social innovation.

As part of the **International Conference on Sustainable Mobility and Climate (#CIMDC2026)**, taking place in **Abidjan from 19 to 22 October 2026 at Hôtel Ivoire**, the International Coalition for Biodiversity Corridors in Africa will organise two key events focusing on ecological connectivity and biodiversity financing.

20 October: Elephant Coalition 2030: launched during the latest Climate Chance Africa Summit in Cotonou, this initiative brings together WWF, Wildlife Conservation Society, CENAGREF, African Elephant Fund, Elephant Protection Initiative, the Ministry of Water and Forests of Côte d'Ivoire, the University of Parakou, Noé and WILD Foundation. The roundtable will provide an opportunity to identify **shared regional priorities for elephant and corridor conservation, ahead of COP17 in Armenia.**

21 October: Innovative Financing for Biodiversity: a workshop bringing together conservation stakeholders and financial partners to share experiences and identify concrete solutions.

Two key opportunities for **sharing initiatives, meeting new partners and strengthening synergies** across the regional ecosystem.
